## Lillehammer

The famous pedestrian street in Lillehammer offers a cosy village feel rarely found in urban settings. Storgata, lined with idyllic wooden town houses, provides the framework for a modern and friendly shopping experience and is an attraction in its own right. Lillehammer is renowned for hosting the Winter Olympics in 1994 and the Winter Youth Olympics in 2016, and has several Olympic Arenas well worth a visit. In Lillehammer you'll find great museums like Maihaugen, Norwegian Olympic Museum and Lillehammer Art Museum

## Hafjell, Hunderfossen and Øyer

Wide range of adventure activities within a small radius: Hafjell Alpine Centre is the ultimate ski resort, offering something to suit all age groups and skill levels. The cross-country ski trails in Hafjell and Øyerfjellet form part of Norway's largest and best trail network. Hunderfossen Winter Park is an enchanting experience in snow and ice. At Lillehammer Olympic Bobsleigh and Luge Track, you get to try adrenaline-filled Olympic activities. Other attractions include the Norwegian Road Museum, Lekeland Hafjell, and many others.

## Sjusjøen and Nordseter

Sjusjøen and Nordseter are the mountain areas closest to Lillehammer. Both are located less than 20 km from the town centre, and offer cross-country ski trails of which several are groomed for freestyle skiing. In March, thousands of skiers participating in the 54 km long Birkebeiner Ski Race pass through Sjusjøen on their way from Rena to Lillehammer. Sjusjøen is also excellent for alpine enthusiasts with Sjusjøen Ski Centre offering downhill skiing as well as a cross-country and biathlon arena.

## Kvitfjell, Venabygdsfjellet and Ringebu

Kvitfjell has spectacular alpine runs, created for the 1994 Winter Olympics. With its varied choice of slopes covering three mountain sides, Kvitfjell Alpine Centre has become a popular ski resort for the whole family. On the eastern side of Gudbrandsdalen are the breathtaking Ringbufjellet, Venabygdsfjellet, and Rondane - a stunning high-mountain experience with way-marked ski trails. Ringebu is often referred to as Norway's smallest town, and has a history as a commercial centre dating back to 1899. Here you will find a wide selection of speciality shops in charming surroundings.

## Vinstra, Gålå, Fagerhøy, Kvamsfjellet and Rondane Nasjonalpark

Visit the central part of Gudbrandsdalen, and discover a spectacular mountain skiing area as well as a host of cultural experiences in an authentic setting. Vinstra forms a famous part of the World of Peer Gynt, and is the region's centre. Gålå offers skiing in gentle high-mountain terrain, and the ski centre Gålå Alpin is perfect for the whole family. Fagerhøy offers well-prepared trails in all wind directions. On the eastern side of the valley is Kvamsfjellet - a gateway to Rondane National Park. In February you can take part in the Furusjøen Rundt race, also known as the Adventure of Rondane.

## Skeikampen, Gausdal, Espedalen and Skåbu

Skeikampen, some 45 minutes by car from Lillehammer, is a resort ideal for cross-country and alpine skiing. It is located in the mountain area known as the World of Peer Gynt, where you also find Kvitfjell, Gålå, and Espedalen. Espedalen in Vestre Gausdal and Sør-Fron is another fantastic starting point for outdoor pursuits, whatever the season. It is also home to Helvete Nature Park featuring Northern Europe's largest potholes. Skåbu offers a vast, varied network of trails, with easy access from several locations.

## Synnfjell and Landsbyen Dokka

Synnfjell is a stunningly beautiful and diverse mountain area between Lillehammer and Valdres, ideal for outdoor activities such as hunting and fishing. Its highest point is the peak Spåtindtoppen at 1414 m above sea level - a popular destination both summer and winter, with panoramic views of Jotunheimen, Rondane, Dokkadalen, and Randsfjorden. With over 350 km of groomed high-quality trails, Synnfjell is ideal for cross-country skiing. Snow conditions are excellent, and the scenery varies from forest terrain to mountain plateaus. The family-friendly ski resort, Spåtind Skisenter, is located by Spåtind Sport Hotel.

# Highlights

## Biathlon season opening at Sjusjøen, 15-17 Nov

Once again, the Norwegian biathlon elite will join other world-class biathletes for a season opening at Sjusjøen. This is one of the few opportunities to experience our top men and women testing their skis and rifles on home snow. The event organiser promises wonderful days with plenty of excitement and high-quality spectator experiences. This year, a new multi-purpose arena will also be in use.

## World Cup Lillehammer 7-8 December

This year's World Cup Nordic Skiing at Lillehammer will be a test of strength and endurance. Athletes competing in the Cup have to partake from the start, and the gruelling trails at Lillehammer will be challenging. Numerous large events have been celebrated at Birkebeineren Ski Stadium, and this is guaranteed to be another hit. This year the sprint is back on the programme, and will be held on Friday 30 November. At the ski jumping arena, the men will go all out for the best possible placing in Nordic Combined, whereas last season's best ski jumper, Maren Lundby, will show off her skills on home ground in what will be the season opening for the women.

With a route leading through breathtaking scenery, the experience is simply stunning. This year, the 45 km Furusjøen Rundt race forms part of Visma Ski Classic Challengers. Distances of 20 km and 12 km are also available.

Raw Air is a thrilling ski jumping tournament taking place at four different locations. Lillehammer will be visited by the world's best ski jumpers on Monday 9 and Tuesday 10 March. This year, for the first time ever, the women will also take part in Raw Air. Lots of people and a brilliant atmosphere guaranteed.

## World Para Snow Sport 9.-20 Dec and 8.-24 March

In the lead-up to the joint World Para Snow Sports Championships in February 2021, Lillehammer will host several test events such as cross-country and biathlon (9 - 20 December), the Snowboard World Cup (8 - 14 March), and the Alpine World Cup (14 - 24 March). The two first will be held at the Birkebeineren Ski Stadium, whereas the two latter will take place in Hafjell. These are important events for our region, and are excellent opportunities to see some great sporting action. All are open to the public, and admission is free.



# Magical ski trips from mountain to mountain

---

With Lillehammer as starting point, you can choose between several spectacular ski trips leading from one mountain to another. Creaking snow beneath your skis, the enchanting winter light, and clean, fresh air in your lungs – a ski trip in the mountain is therapy for the soul! Remember to bring hot chocolate and sandwiches, and maybe some firewood. Daily ski bus services from Lillehammer to Sjusjøen, Nordseter, Hafjell, and Skeikampen.

## Easy with the ski-bus service

The ski bus offers the opportunity to enjoy some excellent skiing from one mountain area to another, without having to pick up your car. It just requires a bit more planning. From Lillehammer, there are several departures daily to Sjusjøen, Nordseter, Hafjell, and Skeikampen.

## Recommended ski trips

### Hafjell - Nordseter/Sjusjøen - 13 km/18 km

From Lillehammer town centre, Hafjell is within easy reach with the ski bus. Take the gondola to Mosetertoppen, put on your skis, and pick up the cross-country trails. There is a slight climb up to Hafjell. Stop for a break at Pellestova before you continue across the mountain. The shortest route from Pellestova to Nordseter follows Reinsvannet by the foot of Nevelfjell. The longest trail leads via Ytre Reina. You can then continue to Sjusjøen, or ski all the way to Lillehammer town centre (29 km). Both Nordseter and Sjusjøen offer a ski bus service back to Lillehammer

### From Nordseter to Sjusjøen or Hafjell - 5 to 25 km

The bus to Nordseter departs from Lillehammer Skysstasjon at 10.00. From Nordseter, there are several trails towards Sjusjøen or Pellestova/Hafjell to choose from. Find the one that suits you best – distances range from 5 km to approx. 25 km. When you have reached your destination, return by bus from Sjusjøen Ski Arena at 14.05 or 16.05 or from Pellestova at 15:55.

Another option is the 11.20 bus from Lillehammer to Sjusjøen, and then return by bus from Nordseter or Pellestova/Hafjell.

# "Travel green" when skiing

At Norway's largest winter resort, we would like to preserve the high-quality air you are here to experience. If more people use bus instead of driving to the mountain in their private cars, emissions will be reduced and there will be cleaner air for all.

## Ski trip with coffee break in Lillehammer

If you are based at Sjusjøen, Nordseter or Hafjell, skiing to Lillehammer town centre is a pleasant and child-friendly trip (slightly further from Hafjell). Visit a café in the welcoming Storgata pedestrian street, and return by bus in the afternoon.

## Motivating ski trip for children - Sjusjøen to Lillehammer town centre - 16 km

Take the ski bus to Sjusjøen, and follow a motivating and fun ski trail with plenty of downhill sections back to Lillehammer town centre. The trip follows the Birkebeiner trail, and is suitable for children aged 7 and up (depending on ski experience). This is the same route as the one used for the children's Birkebeiner race. Starting point is Sjusjøen Ski Arena, and you will follow the Birkebeiner trail for approx. 14 km to Birkebeineren Ski Stadium. Stop for a break at "Skjervald's cabin" (from the Birkebeiner film) and enjoy the view before you zoom down the first downhill section to Sjusjøen. Through this gentle terrain, there several long slopes on the way to Birkebeineren Ski Stadium. Snow conditions permitting, you can continue all the way to Lillehammer town centre. If you opt to stop at the ski stadium, it is possible to return by bus.

## High-mountain trip with a view - Skeikampen rundt - 13 km

If you are looking for a high-mountain skiing experience, then "Skeikampen rundt" is a spectacular - yet not too challenging - round-trip. It is suitable for children, and features numerous fun slopes. Excellent trip in either direction. Both end with a downhill section, but clockwise offers the easiest slopes.

Starting in the forest, the route will take you up into the mountain and back again - with spectacular views along the way. From Skitorget, follow the cross-country ski trail "Skeikampen rundt". Climb uphill until you reach the trail junction in Torsdalsleitet. At this junction, continue straight ahead and enjoy the downhill slope all the way down to the starting point - where waffles and coffee are waiting in the ambient Skeisua mountain-farm café or Nystua café. The trip should not be attempted in high winds or adverse weather conditions.

Take the ski bus from Lillehammer to Skeikampen at 9.15 or 10.15, and return from Skeikampen at 15.40 (weekdays) or 16.40.

## Peer Gynt Trail, from Espedalen to Skeikampen (87 km)

Do you fancy a skiing experience through a beautiful cultural landscape on the western side of Gudbrandsdalen, with fantastic views of the national parks Jotunheimen, Rondane and Dovrefjell? - Then the Peer Gynt Trail may be the one for you!

- The trail leads through Espedalen via Fefor, Gålå, and Kvitfjell to Skeikampen.
- The daily legs are relatively short (14-22 km) and follow gentle mountain terrain, and offer many opportunities for interesting detours
- The entire Peer Gynt Trail is groomed regularly, and standard cross-country skis can be used.
- The trail is suitable for most people who have some cross-country skiing experience.

This trip is also an excellent option for families looking for a slightly challenging, but still a pleasant skiing experience. The entire trail is way-marked with YELLOW on posts and markers. It also offers the added reassurance of leading past mountain lodges and hotels along the way.

## The Troll Trail from Høvringen to Lillehammer (170 km)

Does cross-country skiing across snowclad mountain ranges, where you conquer miles of ski trails in a diverse landscape and stay at traditional hotels or mountain lodges, sound tempting?

- Then the Troll Trail from Rondane and Høvringen to Lillehammer would be the ideal choice for you!
- Through the majestic Rondane National Park in the north, and via a gentler mountain terrain to the Olympic city of Lillehammer in the south.
- 7-day trip with daily legs of 22-38 km.
- Best suited for experienced skiers with a good fitness level.
- The trail is normally way-marked from 15 February until Easter.
- Along the stretch Kvamsfjellet - Venabygdsfjellet, you should expect having to make your own tracks.
- The trail is only partially groomed, and touring skis with metal edges are recommended.

The entire Troll Trail is registered on Skisporet.no - a service providing real-time data on track grooming. This site will keep you up-to-date on when the trails were last groomed, and on the length and altitude of the trip. Remember to always carry a map and compass in the outdoors!

## HOW TO GET AROUND

Gudbrandsdalen offer numerous opportunities for eco-friendly travel. Car is the most convenient form of transport in the region, but bicycle, bus, and train are excellent alternatives. Lillehammer Skysstasjon is the main bus terminal, railway station, and taxi rank. Further north in Gudbrandsdalen, the main transport hubs are Ringebu Skysstasjon and Vinstra Skysstasjon. The E6 (the main north-south artery in Norway) runs through Lillehammer and Gudbrandsdalen.


